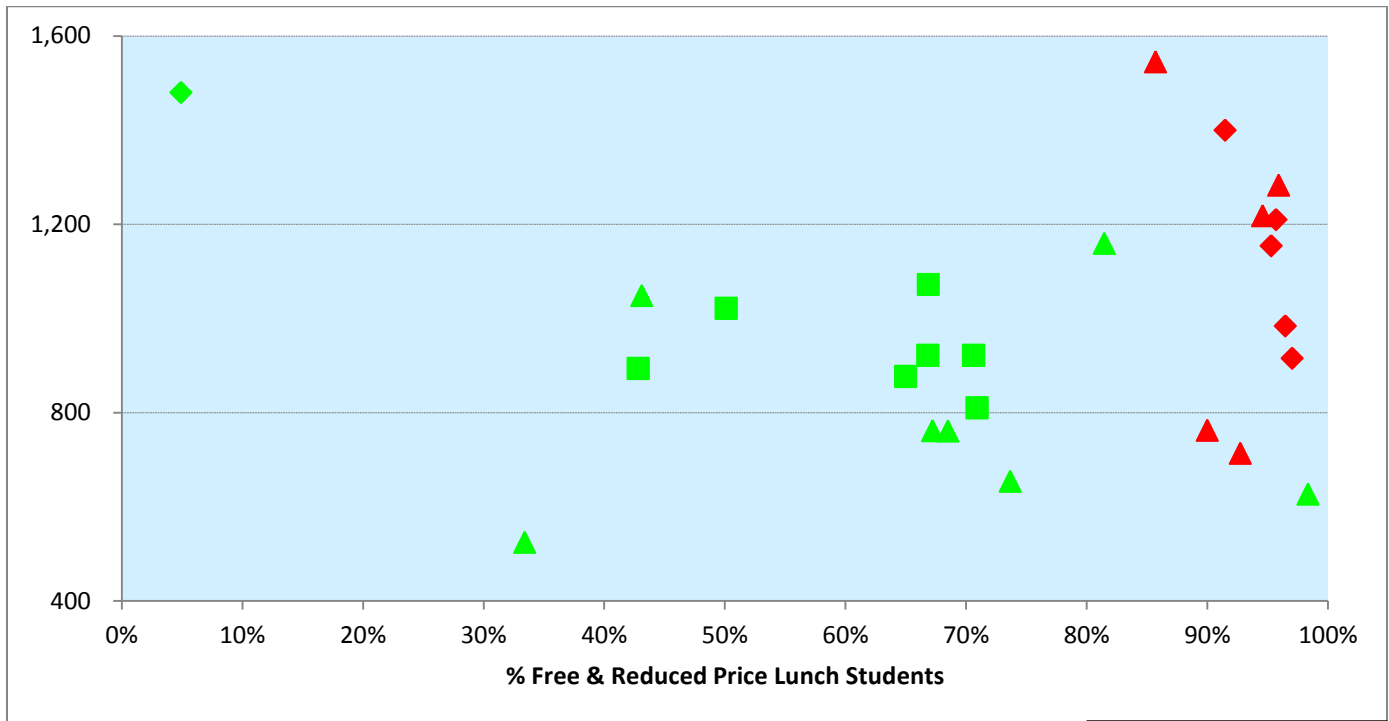
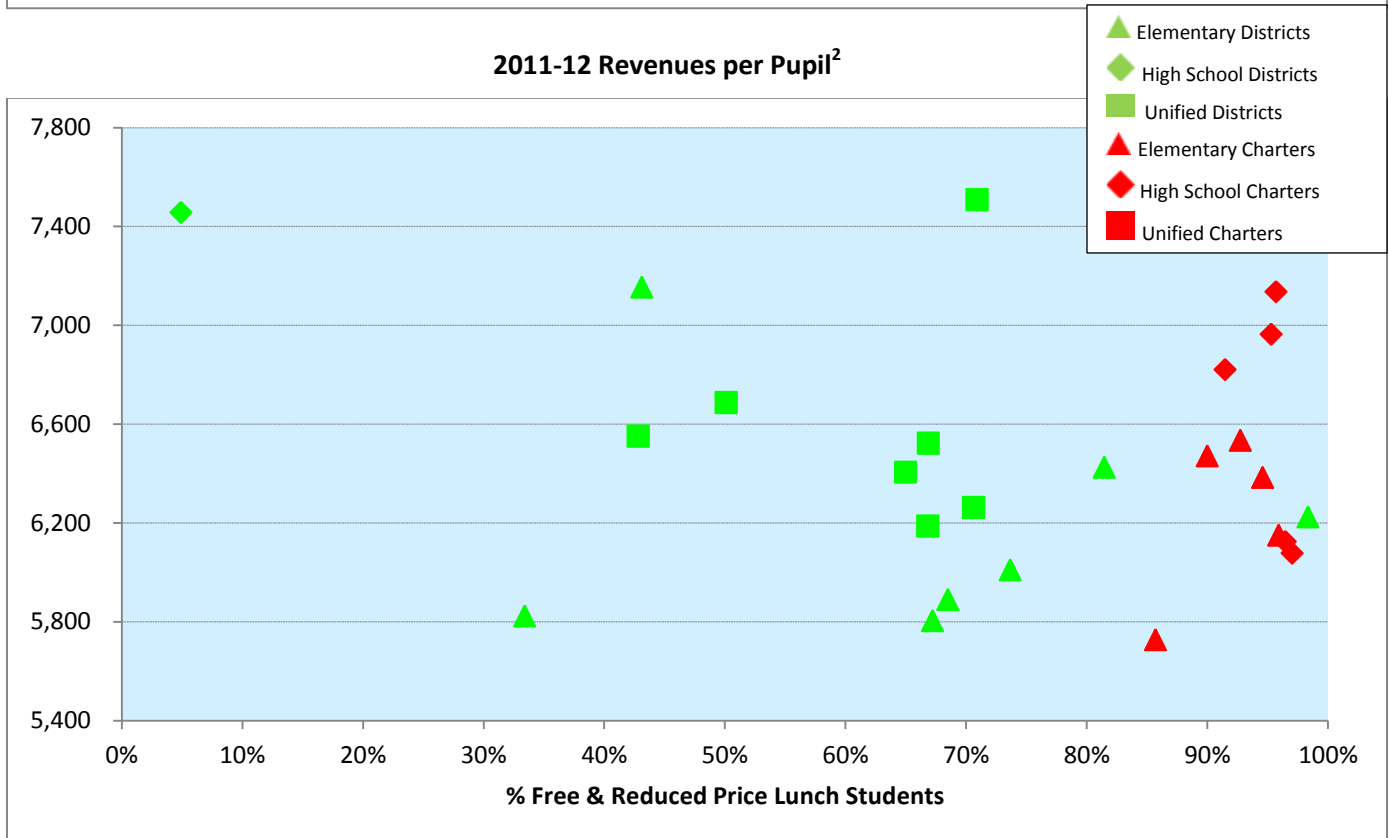


2012-13 Cross-Year Deferrals per Pupil¹
