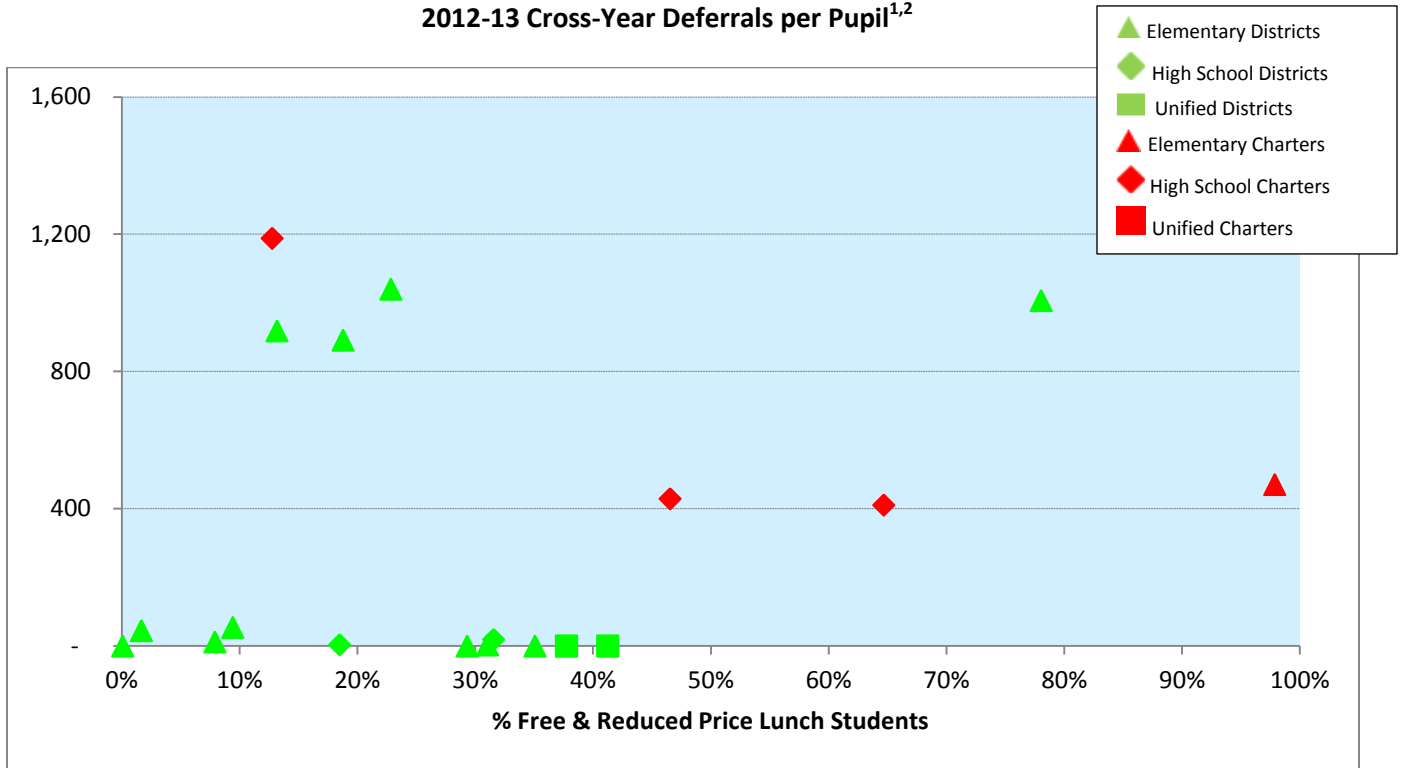
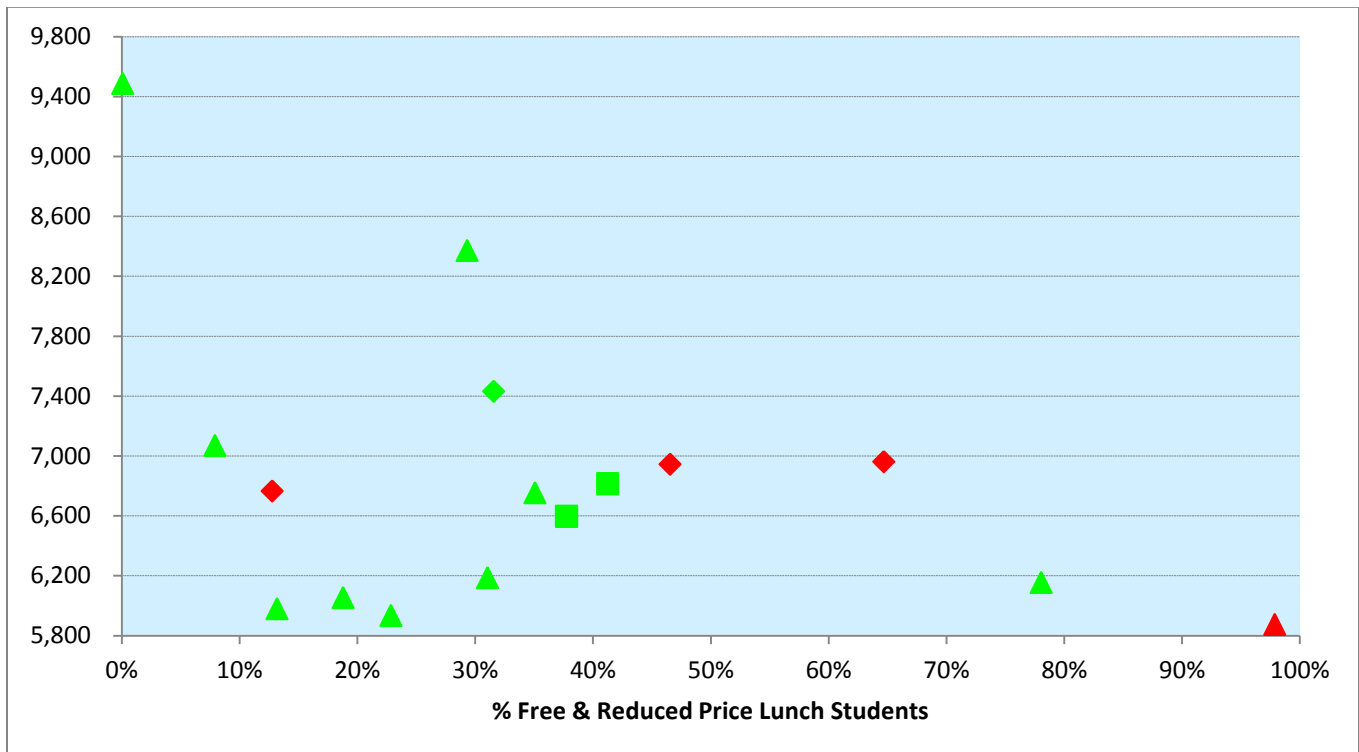


2012-13 Cross-Year Deferrals per Pupil^{1,2}
